Philadelphia is primarily known for the writing of a declaration and the birth of a nation. But the city's legacy includes many other firsts in American history—first national capital, first flag, first university, first fire insurance company, first botanical garden, first hospital, first zoo, first public library, first mint, first public bank, first volunteer fire company, first art museum, and more.

Part of the city's heritage also includes the American Institute for CPCU, which, in April 1942, chose the northeast corner of 36th and Walnut Streets in Philadelphia, near the campus of the University of Pennsylvania, as its first home. This year's conferment brings us full circle.
